To appropriate the sum of \$3,021,734 from the Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap for the purpose of providing partial funding derived from grants under the Second United States Continuing Resolution for government operations during Fiscal Year 2024, and for other purposes.

1	Section 1. The sum of \$3,021,734, or so much
2	thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from
3	the Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap for the
4	purpose of providing partial funding for government
5	operations during Fiscal Year 2024. The sum appropriated
6	shall be deemed from the grant awards for Health,
7	Education, Public (Capacity-building), and Enhanced
8	Reporting and Accountability (ERA) Sectors approved under
9	the Second United States Congress Continuing Resolution
10	and scheduled as follows:
11	(1) Education Sector \$ 1,454,538;
12	(Grant Award No. D24AF00019-01)
13	(2) Health Sector \$ 1,408,100;
14	(Grant Award No. D24AF00018-01)
15	(3) Public Sector/Capacity
16	Building \$ 87,002; and
17	(Grant Award No. D24AF00022-01)
18	(4) ERA Sector \$ 72,094.

2	Section 2. <u>Conditions and Restrictions</u> .
3	(1) Funds herein appropriated under the Amended
4	Compact sector grants shall not be available for
5	obligation for their planned uses by the respective
6	agencies unless the planned uses are unconditionally
7	approved by the Joint Economic Management Committee
8	(JEMCO) under the Amended Compact, and until the
9	respective grant cash amounts have been drawn-down by the
10	State and are deposited in the respective State accounts
11	and available for disbursement. Any amount not
12	unconditionally approved by JEMCO shall be deemed not
13	appropriated herein.
14	(2) The sum appropriated by this Act shall not
15	be advanced to the agency. Memorandum of agreement (MOA)
16	or other forms of agreement the purpose of which is to
17	obligate and disburse to the agency any amounts from the
18	sum appropriated herein, including reimbursements for
19	payments is prohibited.
20	(3) All funds appropriated by this Act shall
21	be maintained under the authority of the Director of the

1	Section 3. Allotment and Management of Funds, and
2	<u>Lapse Date</u> . The sum appropriated by this Act shall be
3	allotted to the Governor who shall be responsible for
4	ensuring these funds are used only for the purposes
5	specified under Section 1 of this Act. The sums
6	appropriated by this Act shall be administered in
7	accordance with the provisions of applicable law,
8	including, but not limited to, the State Financial
9	Management Act of 1983 and the State Contracts Act. The
10	authority to obligate the funds appropriated by this Act
11	shall lapse as of September 30, 2024, and any part of
12	this appropriation not obligated as of September 30, 2024
13	shall revert to the Special Revenue Fund of the State of
14	Yap.
15	Section 4. Reports. The Governor shall submit to
16	the Legislature the performance and financial quarterly
17	reports for each quarter in each fiscal year no later
18	than twenty days after the end of each quarter. Each
19	quarterly report shall include, but not limited to,
20	complete descriptions of the obligations incurred against
21	the funds appropriated by this Act, and the status of
22	the Funds as of the end of the completed quarter.
