

AN ACT

To amend Yap State Law No. 11-20, by amending Section 2 for the purpose of authorizing Yap Visitors Bureau to administer funds appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Yap State Law No. 11-20 is
2 hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 2. Conditions and Restrictions.

4 (1) Lump-sum budget amounts shall not be
5 advanced to any agency, with the exception of Yap
6 Visitors Bureau, at the beginning of the fiscal year.
7 Memorandum of agreement (MOA) or other forms of agreement
8 the purpose of which is to obligate and disburse to a
9 respective agency its annual budget as approved herein,
10 including reimbursements to such agencies for payments
11 for expenditures under their respective budget, is
12 prohibited; PROVIDED, however, that appropriated funds
13 for Yap Visitors Bureau shall be granted pursuant to
14 Section 2 of Yap State Law No. 4-81 and Section 2 of Yap
15 State Law No. 6-24. All funds appropriated by this Act
16 shall be maintained under the authority of the Director
17 of the Office of Administrative Services, with the
18 exception of Yap Visitors Bureau funds.

1 (2) Funds herein appropriated, with the
2 exception of funds appropriated for Yap Visitors Bureau,
3 shall be allotted only on a quarterly basis, except where
4 it is essential for the effective and efficient
5 performance of the duties and responsibilities of an
6 agency to allot certain lump-sum amounts at the beginning
7 of the fiscal year such as for the purchase of fixed
8 assets and for contractual services.

9 (3) Funds appropriated herein for personnel
10 shall not be reprogrammed for other uses.

11 (4) Funds appropriated herein for fixed assets
12 shall not be reprogrammed for other uses after June 30,
13 2024."

14 Section 2. This Act shall take effect upon the
15 approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law
16 without such approval.
